## **14. OLD BUSINESS:**

- Milwaukee Eagles Support
- Scott Griffith shared that PVA-WI needs to solidify an MOU with the WASA Board President and PVA-WI. There is confusion as to the ownership of the Lacrosse team. PVA-WI sponsors the Milwaukee Eagles Lacrosse team; it is not a partnership. The MOU will outline future funding support and representation of the team to avoid future issues with future funding.
- Derrick Trentin shared that he was under the impression that PVA-WI was a partner between PVA-WI and WASA. He also shared that it is a loss for PVA-WI to not support the team. Scott Griffith shared that PVA-WI requested information to resubmit for funding, and the WASA Board President did not resubmit for funding.
- A discussion occurred as to if this program was a line item in the budget. Scott Griffith shared that this program is not a specific budget item for PVA-WI. The initial funding came up about seven years ago through a grant from the Craig Nielsen Foundation. It was the previous ED and Dr. Lee who developed the program, with events run and managed by WASA, who account for this program in their budget. For example. The Big Cheese Wheelchair Lacrosse Tournament is a WASA Tournament. Derrick Trentin shared the uniforms have both WASA and PVA-WI on them.

- Derrick Trentin requested a copy of the letter sent to WASA staff and board. I think it is a big loss for PVA-WI to not support the team. Derrick Trentin stated that WASA would like to continue the relationship. Based on the interactions between the board presidents and staff, WASA decided not to continue the funding relationship this year.
- The intent is to draft an MOU to provide a framework for future collaboration.
